# **CASE STUDY**

Republic Elite Multifamily Interiors Inc. Harrison County PACE, Marshall, TX



*Republic Elite, a manufacturing facility, is Harrison County's first TX-PACE project.* 

## **BACKGROUND**:

Republic Elite has over a half century of experience designing, producing, and installing multifamily kitchens and bathrooms for multifamily interiors. Marshall is home to Republic's manufacturing plant, which specializes in wood cabinetry primarily for use in multi-family housing.

The subject property consists of a 280,000 square foot multi/building/sections woodworking plant that produces cabinetry and other wood building products. Mainly constructed circa 1985 with one older building and some newer smaller sections/buildings.

## THE CHALLENGE:

According to Chief Operating Officer Steve Garwood, the plant had unpredictable operating performance due to equipment failures – particularly in primary processes such as sawing and edge banding that decreased overall productivity, and inefficient processes such as shaker style door production that consumed significant amounts of electrical energy and elevated scrap/re-work rates.

In addition to the productivity impact of unscheduled downtime, many of the machines in place due to the technology used in the controller and drive mechanisms were also inefficient in their use of electrical energy.

Capital for large equipment replacement items was a challenge, so Republic Elite looked for financing alternatives and settled on PACE.

## THE PACE SOLUTION:

Improvements financed via PACE included HVAC upgrades, LED lighting, edge banders, saws and presses plus other related items to support a new shaker style door production method.

Using \$1.5M of TX-PACE financing, the property owners installed new energy efficient equipment, lighting and HVAC throughout the plant.

## THE IMPACT:

- Increased productivity by 40%, increasing unit output, eliminating the need for a second shift
- Improved working conditions, indoor air quality and lighting levels
- Drastically reduced unscheduled equipment downtime
- More predictable operating performance, reduced operating expenses, reduced downtime / improve reliability
- These upgrades will save approximately 3,101,617.39 kWh/year. Financing these improvements to the manufacturing facility will both directly increase energy efficiency as well as drive energy savings by improving manufacturing efficiency.
